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| 14 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: |
| 15 | SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 650, is |

| 17 | Section 650. A. This act <u>section</u> shall be known and may be |
| 18 | cited as the "Oklahoma Interventional Pain Management and Treatment |
| 19 | Act". |
| 20 | B. As used in this section: |
| 21 | 1. "Chronic pain" means a pain state which is subacute, |
| 22 | persistent and intractable; |
| 23 | 2. "Fluoroscope" means a radiologic instrument equipped with a |
| 24 | fluorescent screen on which opaque internal structures can be viewed |

1 as moving shadow images formed by the differential transmission of 2 X-rays throughout the body

"Fluoroscopy" means a medical imaging procedure that uses an X-3 4 ray beam to take real-time footage of moving internal body parts 5 such as bones, muscles, joints, organs, and tissue to display a consistent radiographic picture progressively onto a screen; and 6 7 3. "Interventional pain management" means the practice of medicine delivery of health care services devoted to the diagnosis 8 9 and treatment of chronic pain, through the use of such techniques 10 as: 11 ablation of targeted nerves, a. 12 percutaneous precision needle placement within the b. 13 spinal column with placement of drugs such as local

anesthetics, steroids, <u>and</u> analgesics in targeted
 areas of the spinal column, or

c. surgical techniques, such as laser or endoscopic
 diskectomy, intrathecal infusion pumps and spinal cord
 stimulators, or

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d. <u>fluoroscopy</u>.

C. It shall be unlawful to practice or offer to practice
interventional pain management in this state unless such person has:
<u>1. Has</u> been duly licensed under the provisions of the Oklahoma
Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act or the
Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act; or

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<u>2. Is a certified registered nurse anesthetist licensed in</u>
 <u>accordance with the Oklahoma Nursing Practice Act who holds a valid</u>
 <u>certification in Nonsurgical Pain Management from the National Board</u>
 <u>of Certification and Recertification for Nurse Anesthetists and</u>
 practices in accordance with the certification.

D. Nothing in this section shall be construed to forbid the
administration of lumbar intra-laminar epidural steroid injections
or peripheral nerve blocks by a certified registered nurse
anesthetist when requested to do so by a physician and under the
supervision of <u>A certified registered nurse anesthetist who meets</u>
the criteria of subsection C of this section may:

12 <u>1. Practice interventional pain management, except for surgical</u> 13 <u>techniques, in collaboration with</u> an allopathic or osteopathic 14 physician licensed in this state and under conditions in which 15 timely on-site consultation by such allopathic or osteopathic 16 physician is available.

E. A certified registered nurse anesthetist shall not operate;
 <u>2. Operate</u> a freestanding pain management facility without
 direct supervision of a in collaboration with an allopathic or
 <u>osteopathic</u> physician who is board-certified in interventional pain
 management or its equivalent; and

22 3. Perform procedural sedation.

23 <u>E. Nothing in this section shall authorize a Certified</u>
 24 Registered Nurse Anesthetist to prescribe or dispense any opioid or
