8	An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,
9	Section 1-108, which relates to formation of political parties; modifying requirements for
10	formation of a recognized political party; and providing an effective date.

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 1-108, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1-108. A group of persons may form a recognized
17	political party at any time except during the period between March 1
18	and November 15 of any even-numbered year if the following procedure
19	is observed:
20	1. Notice of intent to form a recognized political party must
21	be filed in writing with the Secretary of the State Election Board
22	at any time except during the period between March 1 and November 15
23	of any even-numbered year;

1	2. After such notice is filed, petitions seeking recognition of
2	a political party, in a form to be prescribed by the Secretary of
3	the State Election Board, shall be filed with such Secretary,
4	bearing the signatures of registered voters equal to at least five
5	percent (5%) one percent (1%) of the total votes cast in the last
6	General Election cither for Governor or for electors for President
7	and Vice President. Each page of such petitions must contain the
8	names of registered voters from a single county. Petitions may be
9	circulated a maximum of one (1) year after notice is filed, provided
10	that petitions shall be filed with the Secretary no later than March
11	1 of an even-numbered year. Such petitions shall not be circulated
12	between March 1 and November 15 of any even-numbered year; and
13	3. Within thirty (30) days after receipt of such petitions, the

- State Election Board shall determine the sufficiency of such petitions. If such Board determines there are a sufficient number of valid signatures of registered voters, the party becomes recognized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma with all rights and obligations accruing thereto.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
