2 constructed, and placed on the State Capitol grounds by private  
3 entities at no expense to the state. The State Capitol Preservation  
4 Commission or designee is authorized to assist private entities in  
5 selecting a location for the monument and arranging a suitable time  
6 for its placement.

7 C. In addition to the Bill of Rights monument described in  
8 subsection B of this section, the State Capitol Preservation  
9 Commission or designee is hereby authorized to permit and arrange  
10 for the placement of a suitable monument on the State Capitol  
11 grounds displaying the 13th, 14th and 15th amendments to the  
12 Constitution of the United States. This monument shall be designed,  
13 constructed and placed next to the Bill of Rights monument on the  
14 State Capitol grounds by private entities at no expense to the  
15 state. The State Capitol Preservation Commission or designee is  
16 authorized to assist private entities in selecting a location for  
17 the monument and arranging a suitable time for its placement.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
