14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-102.1 of Title 30, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. Any person interested in the welfare of a minor who is at
18	least seventeen (17) years and six (6) months of age and believed to
19	be an incapacitated person or partially incapacitated person may
20	initiate guardianship proceedings, file a petition pursuant to
21	Section 3-101 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes and request that
22	any guardianship order take effect immediately on the minor's
23	eighteenth birthday.

The petitioner may provide with the petition a copy of the results of an evaluation of the minor by a physician, psychologist or other appropriate professional evaluation that meets the requirements of subsection C of Section 3-101 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes. If the evaluation was conducted within sixty (60) days prior to the filing of the petition, the petitioner may ask in the petition that the court accept this report in lieu of ordering any additional evaluation pursuant to Section 3-108 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statues, and the court may grant the request. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017. 56-1-5444 MMA 12/19/16
