6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; authorizing school  
8 district to offer law enforcement elective course to  
9 juniors and seniors; listing certain information to  
10 be included in course; permitting State Board of  
11 Education to coordinate with the Council on Law  
12 Enforcement Education and Training; authorizing Board  
13 to promulgate rules; providing for codification; and  
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.15 of Title 70, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. A school district may offer to students in grades eleven and  
20 twelve an elective course in law enforcement.

21 B. The law enforcement elective course shall include, at a  
22 minimum:

- 23 1. A general introduction to law enforcement training;
- 24 2. Critical skills and entry requirements for law enforcement  
professionals; and
3. Career opportunities in law enforcement.

1 C. The State Board of Education may coordinate with the Council  
2 on Law Enforcement Education and Training to develop instructional  
3 materials and curricula for school districts to use in the law  
4 enforcement elective course. The Board may promulgate rules to  
5 implement the provisions of this section.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
