19	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

22	A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving

1 Shooting, and Precision Sports Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a 2 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the State Board of Agriculture 3 from state-appropriated funds, federal funds, donations, grants, and 4 5 contributions from any public or private source and designated for the purpose set forth in this section. All monies accruing to the 6 credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and 7 expended by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 8 9 Forestry for the purpose of administering the International Livestock Judging Competition, Shooting, and Precision Sports Grant 10 Act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued 11 12 by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 13 Services for approval and payment. 14

B. The International Livestock Judging Competition, Shooting,
and Precision Sports Revolving Fund shall never exceed Five Hundred
Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) at any given time.

18 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21-3 of Title 2, unless there is 20 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall administer the provisions of the International Livestock Judging Competition, Shooting, and Precision Sports Grant Act.

1	B. The State Board of Agriculture shall promulgate rules and
2	adopt eligibility guidelines necessary to enforce and administer the
3	International Livestock Judging Competition, Shooting, and Precision
4	Sports Grant Act, including an application process for grants.
5	Teams that receive grants must be comprised of Oklahoma students who
6	are members of a National FFA Organization chapter or 4-H team that
7	has won a national competition and is eligible to compete in an
8	international livestock judging competition or members of a shooting
9	and precision sports team that is eligible to compete in a national
10	or international sports competition.
11	C. Grants shall be awarded to match the funds the teams have
12	raised in a one-to-one ratio (1:1), the total amount not to exceed
13	the estimated cost of the trip for an international livestock
14	judging competition.
15	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
