6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; requiring school  
8 districts to offer certain program; requiring State  
9 Board of Education to promulgate certain rules;  
10 urging Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to  
11 promulgate certain rules; providing certain  
12 construction; providing for codification; providing  
13 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-107.1 of Title 70, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year, each school  
19 district shall offer a program in which students may earn the  
20 equivalent of at least twelve (12) semester credit hours of college  
21 credit in high school.

22 B. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to  
23 implement the program.

1 C. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma State  
2 Regents for Higher Education promulgate rules to implement the  
3 program.

4 D. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require a  
5 school district to pay a student's tuition or other associated costs  
6 for taking a course that is available through the program.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
9 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
