For purposes of this section, "governmental entity" 22 includes, but is not limited to, any elected or appointed state or 23 local official, any political subdivision, and any agency, board, 24

commission, or council with rule-making authority. The prohibition

4	B. No governmental entity shall discriminate against or pursue
