An Act relating to revenue and taxation; repealing 68 O.S. 2011, Section 1367.1, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 329, O.S.L. 2014 (68 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1367.1), which relates to certain deductions from sales tax collections; repealing 68 O.S. 2011, Section 1410.1, which relates to certain deductions from use tax collections; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Sales and use tax deductions

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. REPEALER 68 O.S. 2011, Section 1367.1, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 329, O.S.L. 2014 (68 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1367.1), is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. REPEALER 68 O.S. 2011, Section 1410.1, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
