6 An Act relating to park model recreational vehicles;
7 amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1102, as last amended
8 by Section 1, Chapter 229, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp.
9 2015, Section 1102), which relates to Oklahoma
10 Vehicle License and Registration Act definitions;
11 adding definition for park model recreational
12 vehicle; modifying definitions; amending 68 O.S.
13 2011, Section 2101, which relates to vehicle excise
14 tax definitions; modifying definition; and providing
15 an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1102, as
18 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 229, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp.
19 2015, Section 1102), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 1102. As used in the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
21 Registration Act:

22 1. "All-terrain vehicle" means a vehicle manufactured and used
23 exclusively for off-highway use traveling on four or more non-
24 highway tires, and being fifty (50) inches or less in width;

2. "Carrying capacity" means the carrying capacity of a vehicle
as determined or declared in tons of cargo or payload by the owner;
provided, that such declared capacity shall not be less than the

1 minimum tonnage capacity fixed, listed or advertised by the
2 manufacturer of any vehicle;

3 3. "Certificate of title" means a document which is proof of
4 legal ownership of a motor vehicle as described and provided for in
5 Section 1105 of this title;

6 4. "Chips and oil" or the term "road oil and crushed rock"
7 means, with respect to materials authorized for use in the surfacing
8 of roads or highways in this title or in any equivalent statute
9 pertaining to road or highway surfacing in the State of Oklahoma,
10 any asphaltic materials. Wherever chips and oil or road oil and
11 crushed rock are authorized for use in the surfacing of roads or
12 highways in this state, whether by the Department of Transportation,
13 or by the county commissioners, or other road building authority
14 subject to the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act,
15 asphaltic materials are also authorized for use in such surfacing
16 and construction;

17 5. "Combined laden weight" means the weight of a truck or
18 station wagon and its cargo or payload transported thereon, or the
19 weight of a truck or truck-tractor plus the weight of any trailers
20 or semitrailers together with the cargo or payload transported
21 thereon;

22 6. "Commercial trailer" means any trailer, as defined in
23 Section 1-180 of this title, or semitrailer, as defined in Section
24

1 1-162 of this title, when such trailer or semitrailer is used
2 primarily for business or commercial purposes;

3 7. "Commercial trailer dealer" means any person, firm or
4 corporation engaged in the business of selling any new and unused,
5 or used, or both new and used commercial trailers;

6 8. "Commercial vehicle" means any vehicle over eight thousand
7 (8,000) pounds combined laden weight used primarily for business or
8 commercial purposes. Each motor vehicle being registered pursuant
9 to the provisions of this section shall have the name of the
10 commercial establishment or the words "Commercial Vehicle"
11 permanently and prominently displayed upon the outside of the
12 vehicle in letters not less than two (2) inches high. Such letters
13 shall be in sharp contrast to the background and shall be of
14 sufficient shape and color as to be readily legible during daylight
15 hours, from a distance of fifty (50) feet while the vehicle is not
16 in motion;

17 9. "Commission" or "Tax Commission" means the Oklahoma Tax
18 Commission;

19 10. "Construction machinery" means machines or devices drawn as
20 trailers which are designed and used for construction, tree trimming
21 and waste maintenance projects, which derive no revenue from the
22 transportation of persons or property, whose use of the highway is
23 only incidental and which are not mounted or affixed to another
24

1 vehicle; provided, construction machinery shall not include
2 implements of husbandry as defined in Section 1-125 of this title;

3 11. "Dealer" means any person, firm, association, corporation
4 or trust who sells, solicits or advertises the sale of new and
5 unused motor vehicles and holds a bona fide contract or franchise in
6 effect with a manufacturer or distributor of a particular make of
7 new or unused motor vehicle or vehicles for the sale of same;

8 12. "Mini-truck" means a foreign-manufactured import or
9 domestic-manufactured vehicle powered by an internal combustion
10 engine with a piston or rotor displacement of one thousand cubic
11 centimeters (1,000 cu cm) or less, which is sixty-seven (67) inches
12 or less in width, with an unladen dry weight of three thousand four
13 hundred (3,400) pounds or less, traveling on four or more tires,
14 having a top speed of approximately fifty-five (55) miles per hour,
15 equipped with a bed or compartment for hauling, and having an
16 enclosed passenger cab;

17 13. "Interstate commerce" means any commerce moving between any
18 place in a state and any place in another state or between places in
19 the same state through another state;

20 14. "Laden weight" means the combined weight of a vehicle when
21 fully equipped for use and the cargo or payload transported thereon;
22 provided, that in no event shall the laden weight be less than the
23 unladen weight of the vehicle fully equipped for use, plus the
24 manufacturer's rated carrying capacity;

1 15. "Local authorities" means every county, municipality or
2 local board or body having authority to adopt police regulations
3 under the Constitution and laws of this state;

4 16. "Low-speed electrical vehicle" means any four-wheeled
5 electrical vehicle that is powered by an electric motor that draws
6 current from rechargeable storage batteries or other sources of
7 electrical current and whose top speed is greater than twenty (20)
8 miles per hour but not greater than twenty-five (25) miles per hour
9 and is manufactured in compliance with the National Highway Traffic
10 Safety Administration standards for low-speed vehicles in 49 C.F.R.
11 571.500;

12 17. "Manufactured home" means a residential dwelling built in
13 accordance with the National Manufactured Housing Construction and
14 Safety Standards Act of 1974, 42 U.S.C., Section 5401 et seq., and
15 rules promulgated pursuant thereto and the rules promulgated by the
16 Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission pursuant to Section
17 582 of this title. Manufactured home shall not mean a park model
18 recreational vehicle as defined in this section;

19 18. "Manufactured home dealer" means any person, firm or
20 corporation engaged in the business of selling any new and unused,
21 or used, or both new and used manufactured homes. Such information
22 and a valid franchise letter as proof of authorization to sell any
23 such new manufactured home product line or lines shall be attached
24 to the application for a dealer license to sell manufactured homes.

1 "Manufactured home dealer" shall not include any person, firm or
2 corporation who sells or contracts for the sale of the dealer's own
3 personally titled manufactured home or homes. No person, firm or
4 corporation shall be considered a manufactured home dealer as to any
5 manufactured home purchased or acquired by such person, firm or
6 corporation for purposes other than resale; provided, that the
7 restriction set forth in this sentence shall not prevent an
8 otherwise qualified person, firm or corporation from utilizing a
9 single manufactured home as a sales office;

10 19. "Medium-speed electrical vehicle" means any self-propelled,
11 electrically powered four-wheeled motor vehicle, equipped with a
12 roll cage or crush-proof body design, whose speed attainable in one
13 (1) mile is more than thirty (30) miles per hour but not greater
14 than thirty-five (35) miles per hour;

15 20. "Motor license agent" means any person appointed,
16 designated or authorized by the Oklahoma Tax Commission to collect
17 the fees and to enforce the provisions provided for in the Oklahoma
18 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

19 21. "New vehicle" or "unused vehicle" means a vehicle which has
20 been in the possession of the manufacturer, distributor or
21 wholesaler or has been sold only by the manufacturer, distributor or
22 wholesaler to a dealer;

23 22. "Nonresident" means any person who is not a resident of
24 this state;

1 23. "Off-road motorcycle" means any motorcycle, as defined in
2 Section 1-135 of this title, when such motorcycle has been
3 manufactured for and used exclusively off roads, highways and any
4 other paved surfaces;

5 24. "Owner" means any person owning, operating or possessing
6 any vehicle herein defined;

7 25. "Park model recreational vehicle" means a vehicle that is:

8 a. designed and marketed as temporary living quarters for
9 camping, recreational, seasonal or travel use,

10 b. not permanently affixed to real property for use as a
11 permanent dwelling,

12 c. built on a single chassis mounted on wheels with a
13 gross trailer area not exceeding four hundred (400)
14 square feet in the setup mode, and

15 d. certified by the manufacturer as complying with
16 standard A119.5 of the American National Standards
17 Institute, Inc.;

18 26. "Person" means any individual, copartner, joint venture,
19 association, corporation, limited liability company, estate, trust,
20 business trust, syndicate, the State of Oklahoma, or any county,
21 city, municipality, school district or other political subdivision
22 thereof, or any group or combination acting as a unit, or any
23 receiver appointed by the state or federal court;

24 ~~26.~~ 27. "Rebodied vehicle" means a vehicle:

- 1 a. which has been assembled using a new body or new major
2 component which is of the identical type as the
3 original vehicle and is licensed by the manufacturer
4 of the original vehicle and other original, new or
5 reconditioned parts. For purposes of this paragraph,
6 "new body or new major component" means a new body,
7 cab, frame, front end clip or rear end clip,
8 b. which is not a salvage, rebuilt, or junked vehicle as
9 defined by paragraph 1, 2, or 6 of subsection A of
10 Section 1105 of this title, and
11 c. for which the Tax Commission has assigned or will
12 assign a new identifying number;

13 ~~27.~~ 28. "Recreational off-highway vehicle" means a vehicle
14 manufactured and used exclusively for off-highway use, traveling on
15 four or more non-highway tires, and being sixty-five (65) inches or
16 less in width;

17 ~~28.~~ 29. "Recreational vehicle" means every vehicle which is
18 built on or permanently attached to a self-propelled motor chassis
19 or chassis cab which becomes an integral part of the completed
20 vehicle and is capable of being operated on the highways. In order
21 to qualify as a recreational vehicle pursuant to this paragraph such
22 vehicle shall be permanently constructed and equipped for human
23 habitation, having its own sleeping and kitchen facilities,
24 including permanently affixed cooking facilities, water tanks and

1 holding tank with permanent toilet facilities. Recreational vehicle
2 shall not include manufactured homes or any vehicle with portable
3 sleeping, toilet and kitchen facilities which are designed to be
4 removed from such vehicle. Recreational vehicle shall include park
5 model recreational vehicles as defined in this section;

6 ~~29.~~ 30. "Remanufactured vehicle" means a vehicle which has been
7 assembled by a vehicle remanufacturer using a new body and which may
8 include original, reconditioned, or remanufactured parts, and which
9 is not a salvage, rebuilt, or junked vehicle as defined by
10 paragraphs 1, 2, and 6, respectively, of subsection A of Section
11 1105 of this title;

12 ~~30.~~ 31. "Rental trailer" means all small or utility trailers or
13 semitrailers constructed and suitable for towing by a passenger
14 automobile and designed only for carrying property, when the
15 trailers or semitrailers are owned by, or are in the possession of,
16 any person engaged in renting or leasing such trailers or
17 semitrailers for intrastate or interstate use or combined intrastate
18 and interstate use;

19 ~~31.~~ 32. "Special mobilized machinery" means special purpose
20 machines or devices, either self-propelled or drawn as trailers or
21 semitrailers, which derive no revenue from the transportation of
22 persons or property, whose use of the highway is only incidental,
23 and whose useful revenue producing service is performed at
24

1 destinations in an area away from the traveled surface of an
2 established open highway;

3 ~~32.~~ 33. "State" means the State of Oklahoma;

4 ~~33.~~ 34. "Station wagon" means any passenger vehicle which does
5 not have a separate luggage compartment or trunk and which does not
6 have open beds, and has one or more rear seats readily lifted out or
7 folded, whether same is called a station wagon or ranch wagon;

8 ~~34.~~ 35. "Travel trailer" means any vehicular portable structure
9 built on a chassis, used as a temporary dwelling for travel,
10 recreational or vacation use, and, when factory-equipped for the
11 road, it shall have a body width not exceeding eight (8) feet and an
12 overall length not exceeding forty (40) feet, including the hitch or
13 coupling;

14 ~~35.~~ 36. "Travel trailer dealer" means any person, firm or
15 corporation engaged in the business of selling any new and unused,
16 or used, or both new and used travel trailers. Such information and
17 a valid franchise letter as proof of authorization to sell any such
18 new travel trailer product line or lines shall be attached to the
19 application for a dealer license to sell travel trailers. "Travel
20 trailer dealer" shall not include any person, firm or corporation
21 who sells or contracts for the sale of his or her own personally
22 titled travel trailer or trailers. No person, firm or corporation
23 shall be considered as a travel trailer dealer as to any travel
24

1 trailer purchased or acquired by such person, firm or corporation
2 for purposes other than resale;

3 ~~36.~~ 37. "Used motor vehicle dealer" means "used motor vehicle
4 dealer" as defined in Section 581 of this title;

5 ~~37.~~ 38. "Used vehicle" means any vehicle which has been sold,
6 bargained, exchanged or given away, or used to the extent that it
7 has become what is commonly known, and generally recognized, as a
8 "secondhand" vehicle. This shall also include any vehicle other
9 than a remanufactured vehicle, regardless of age, owned by any
10 person who is not a dealer;

11 ~~38.~~ 39. "Utility vehicle" means a vehicle powered by an
12 internal combustion engine, manufactured and used exclusively for
13 off-highway use, equipped with seating for two or more people and a
14 steering wheel, traveling on four or more wheels;

15 ~~39.~~ 40. "Vehicle" means any type of conveyance or device in,
16 upon or by which a person or property is or may be transported from
17 one location to another upon the avenues of public access within the
18 state. "Vehicle" does not include bicycles, trailers except travel
19 trailers and rental trailers, or implements of husbandry as defined
20 in Section 1-125 of this title. All implements of husbandry used as
21 conveyances shall be required to display the owner's driver license
22 number or license plate number of any vehicle owned by the owner of
23 the implement of husbandry on the rear of the implement in numbers
24 not less than two (2) inches in height. The use of the owner's

1 social security number on the rear of the implement of husbandry
2 shall not be required; and

3 ~~40.~~ 41. "Vehicle remanufacturer" means a commercial entity
4 which assembles remanufactured vehicles.

5 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 2101, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 Section 2101. For the purpose of this article:

8 1. The term "motor vehicle" means and includes every
9 automobile, truck, truck-tractor, all-terrain vehicle, utility
10 vehicle or any motor bus or any self-propelled vehicle not operated
11 or driven upon fixed rails or tracks or in the air or on water;

12 2. The term "vehicle" means and includes every device in, upon,
13 or by which any person or property is, or may be, transported or
14 drawn, excepting devices moved by human or animal power, when not
15 used upon fixed rails or tracks, or in the air or on water;

16 3. The term "low-speed electrical vehicle" means and includes
17 any four-wheeled electrical vehicle that is powered by an electric
18 motor that draws current from rechargeable storage batteries or
19 other sources of electrical current and whose top speed is greater
20 than twenty (20) miles per hour but not greater than twenty-five
21 (25) miles per hour and is manufactured in compliance with the
22 National Highway Traffic Safety Administration standards for low-
23 speed vehicles in 49 C.F.R. 571.500;

24

1 4. The term "automobile" means and includes every motor vehicle
2 constructed and used solely for the transportation of persons for
3 purposes other than for hire or compensation;

4 5. The term "motorcycle" means and includes every motor vehicle
5 designed to travel on not more than three wheels other than an all-
6 terrain vehicle;

7 6. The term "truck" means and includes every motor vehicle
8 constructed or used for the transportation of property not falling
9 within the definition of truck-tractor, trailer or semitrailer, as
10 herein defined;

11 7. The term "truck-tractor" means and includes every motor
12 vehicle of the truck type designed to draw or support the front end
13 of a semitrailer;

14 8. The term "trailer" means and includes any vehicle designed
15 to be drawn by a truck, tractor or a truck-tractor, but supported
16 upon its own wheels;

17 9. The term "semitrailer" means and includes any vehicle
18 designed to be attached to, and having its front end supported by a
19 truck, tractor, or truck-tractor;

20 10. The term "motor bus" means and includes every motor vehicle
21 constructed so as to carry persons, and which is used or rented to
22 carry persons for compensation;

23 11. The term "manufactured home" means a residential dwelling
24 built in accordance with the National Manufactured Housing

1 Construction and Safety Standards Act of 1974, 42 U.S.C., Section
2 5401 et seq., and rules promulgated pursuant thereto and the rules
3 promulgated by the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission
4 pursuant to Section 582 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

5 Manufactured home shall not mean a park model recreational vehicle
6 as defined in Section 1102 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

7 12. The term "farm tractor" means and includes any vehicle of
8 tractor type owned and operated by the purchaser and used
9 exclusively for agricultural purposes;

10 13. The term "all-terrain vehicle" means and includes every
11 vehicle defined as an all-terrain vehicle in Section 1102 of Title
12 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13 14. The terms "legal ownership" and "legally owned" mean the
14 right to possession, whether acquired by purchase, barter, exchange,
15 assignment, gift, operation of law, or in any other manner;

16 15. The term "person" means and includes natural persons,
17 individuals, partnerships, firms, associations, limited liability
18 companies, corporations, estates, trustees, business trusts,
19 syndicates, this state, any county, city, municipality, school
20 district or other political subdivision of the state, or any
21 corporation or combination acting as a unit or any receiver
22 appointed by any state or federal court; and the use of the singular
23 number shall include the plural number;

24

1 16. The term "Tax Commission" means the Oklahoma Tax
2 Commission;

3 17. The term "utility vehicle" means every vehicle defined as a
4 utility vehicle in Section 1102 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
5 Statutes; and

6 18. The term "medium-speed electrical vehicle" means any self-
7 propelled, electrically powered four-wheeled motor vehicle, equipped
8 with a roll cage or crush-proof body design, whose speed attainable
9 in one (1) mile is more than thirty (30) miles per hour but not
10 greater than thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

11 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
