

1 2. Has reasonable cause to believe that forcible entry into the
2 motor vehicle is necessary because the animal is in imminent danger
3 of suffering harm if not immediately removed from the motor vehicle
4 and, based upon the circumstances known to the officer at the time,
5 the belief is a reasonable one;

6 3. Places a notice on the motor vehicle windshield with the
7 officer's contact information, the reason the entry was made and the
8 location of the animal;

9 4. Sends the animal to an animal shelter or remains with the
10 animal in a safe location, out of the elements but reasonably close
11 to the motor vehicle; and

12 5. Uses no more force to enter the motor vehicle and remove the
13 animal from the motor vehicle than is necessary under the
14 circumstances.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
