15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-503.1 of Title 63, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Any hospital, physician or other licensed health care
19	provider who sees or treats a patient whom the provider, in his or
20	her professional opinion, believes to be suffering from an adverse
21	reaction to a vaccination shall report such adverse reaction to the
22	State Department of Health within twenty-four (24) hours of seeing

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or treating the patient.

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- The State Department of Health shall compile all reports of adverse reactions to vaccinations and shall provide a quarterly report to the Legislature. The report provided to the Legislature shall be made available to the public on the Department's website, with a direct link from the homepage.
- C. Any information collected, compiled, or published pursuant to this section shall be collected, compiled, or published in such a way that no person can be identified except as required or authorized by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996.
- 11 The State Department of Health shall promulgate such rules 12 as it deems necessary to implement the provisions of this section. 13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
