6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health; requiring reporting
8 of adverse responses to vaccines; requiring State
9 Board of Health to compile and publish reports;
10 requiring State Board of Health to provide quarterly
11 reports to Legislature; requiring compliance with
12 certain privacy provision; requiring promulgation of
13 rules; providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-503.1 of Title 63, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Any hospital, physician or other licensed health care
20 provider who sees or treats a patient whom the provider, in his or
21 her professional opinion, believes to be suffering from an adverse
22 reaction to a vaccination shall report such adverse reaction to the
23 State Department of Health within twenty-four (24) hours of seeing
24 or treating the patient.

1 B. The State Department of Health shall compile all reports of
2 adverse reactions to vaccinations and shall provide a quarterly
3 report to the Legislature. The report provided to the Legislature
4 shall be made available to the public on the Department's website,
5 with a direct link from the homepage.

6 C. Any information collected, compiled, or published pursuant
7 to this section shall be collected, compiled, or published in such a
8 way that no person can be identified except as required or
9 authorized by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability
10 Act of 1996.

11 D. The State Department of Health shall promulgate such rules
12 as it deems necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
