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	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
20	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-863 of Title 63, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. The Department of Corrections may establish a Nurse Aide
24	training program for eligible inmates, who are in work assignments,

- 1 | which will provide long term end-of-life care to fellow inmates.
- 2 | The curriculum will follow established training requirements for
- 3 | Nurse Aides as provided in Section 1-1951 of Title 63 of the
- 4 Oklahoma Statutes. The Chief Medical Officer of the Department of
- 5 | Corrections will have oversight of the training program.
- B. Inmates with convictions pursuant to the provisions of
- 7 | Section 1-1950.1 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes are prohibited
- 8 | from participation unless written permission to participate is
- 9 granted by the State Department of Health. Eligible inmates are
- 10 | subject to a criminal background check, as provided in Section 1-
- 11 | 1947 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- 12 C. Upon successful completion of the training program provided
- 13 | for in this section, the Department of Corrections shall issue a
- 14 program completion certificate to the inmate. The Department of
- 15 | Corrections in cooperation with the Department of Health and the
- 16 Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education shall develop
- 17 | appropriate processes to submit notice of training completion and
- 18 application for licensure or certification to the State Department
- 19 of Health in a manner prescribed by the State Department of Health.
- D. The Department of Corrections, in consultation with the
- 21 | State Department of Health, shall have authority to promulgate rules
- 22 to maintain the curriculum established pursuant to subsection A of
- 23 this section.

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1	E. Nothing in this section shall be construed to establish a
2	right to employment with any licensed hospice provider.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
