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L 4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L5	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Rule 5.6 of the Rules of the
L 6	Ethics Commission (74 O.S. Supp. 2015, Ch. 62, App. I), is amended
L7	to read as follows:
L8	Rule 5.6 Except as provided in these Rules, a legislative
L 9	liaison, a legislative lobbyist or a lobbyist principal by whom the
20	legislative liaison or legislative lobbyist is employed or retained
21	shall provide no gift to the Governor, a legislator or any employee
22	of the Governor or the Legislature. The Governor, a legislator or
23	any employee of the Governor or the Legislature shall not knowingly

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accept anything of value from a legislative liaison, a legislative

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lobbyist or a lobbyist principal by whom the legislative liaison or legislative lobbyist is employed or retained except as permitted by these Rules. Except as provided in these Rules, an executive lobbyist or a lobbyist principal by whom the executive lobbyist is employed or retained shall provide nothing of value to any officer or employee of an agency that is the subject of the executive lobbyist's lobbying activities. No officer or employee of an agency that is subject to an executive lobbyist's lobbying activities shall knowingly accept anything of value from an executive lobbyist or a lobbyist principal by whom an executive lobbyist is employed except as permitted by these Rules. In no event shall a legislative liaison, a legislative lobbyist, an executive lobbyist or a lobbyist principal indirectly provide anything of value to any state officer or employee by providing a thing of value to a family member of the state officer or employee, other than as permitted by these Rules. In no event shall the costs of a thing of value provided by a legislative liaison or legislative lobbyist to the Governor, a legislator or any employee of the Governor or the Legislature permitted by these Rules be divided or shared with other legislative liaisons or legislative lobbyists in filing a report required by these Rules unless otherwise provided by these Rules. Agencies may provide two (2) tickets or admissions to any conference, seminar, lecture or similar event held within the boundaries of the State of Oklahoma and sponsored in whole or in part by the agency to the

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    Governor, any individual legislator or any individual employee of
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    the Governor or the Legislature, provided the tickets or admissions
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    are used by the recipient and a family member of the recipient.
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    Notwithstanding any other provision of these Rules, a lobbyist
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    principal shall not provide anything of value to the Governor, a
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    legislator or any employee of the Governor or the Legislature, the
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    value of which exceeds Fifty Dollars ($50.00) in a calendar year,
    regardless of the number of lobbyists representing the lobbyist
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    principal.

                                     Rule 5.7 of the Rules of the
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    Ethics Commission (74 O.S. Supp. 2015, Ch. 62, App. I), is amended
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    to read as follows:
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        Rule 5.7 A legislative liaison, or a legislative lobbyist
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    representing only one lobbyist principal, shall pay no more than
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    Five Hundred Dollars ($500.00) Fifty Dollars ($50.00) per calendar
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    year for meals for the Governor, for any individual legislator or
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    for any individual employee of the Governor or the Legislature,
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    regardless of the source of funds used for payment. A legislative
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    lobbyist representing more than one lobbyist principal shall pay no
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more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per calendar year for meals

for the Governor, for any individual legislator or for any

individual employee of the Governor or the Legislature, regardless

of the source of funds used for payment. Notwithstanding any other

provision of these Rules, a lobbyist principal shall not provide

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anything of value to the Governor, an individual legislator or any
individual employee of the Governor or the Legislature, the value of
which exceeds Fifty Dollars ($50.00) in a calendar year, regardless
of the number of lobbyists representing the lobbyist principal. Any
meal purchased in accordance with this section shall be reported to
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- 6 the Oklahoma Ethics Commission. The report shall contain the
- 7 <u>following information:</u>
 - 1. The name of the person purchasing the meal;
 - 2. The name of the person receiving the meal;
 - 3. The amount of the meal;
 - 4. The location of the meal;
 - 5. The name of the entity from where the meal was purchased;
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- 14 6. The date the meal was served.
- SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Rule 5.8 of the Rules of the

 Ethics Commission (74 O.S. Supp. 2015, Ch. 62, App. I), is amended

 to read as follows:
 - Rule 5.8 A legislative liaison or a legislative lobbyist may make a gift to the Governor or any legislator or any employee of the Governor or the Legislature in recognition of infrequently occurring occasions of personal significance. Such gifts may be made to a family member of the Governor or any legislator or any employee of the Governor or the Legislature, provided such family member is a party to a marriage, serious illness, birth or adoption of a child

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    or retirement. Such gifts to any individual recipient may not
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    exceed Two Hundred Dollars ($200.00) Fifty Dollars ($50.00) in the
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    aggregate in any calendar year from any legislative liaison or
    legislative lobbyist. Any such gifts shall be aggregated with
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    meals, and the aggregate total of meals and other gifts provided to
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    an individual recipient by a:
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        1. A legislative liaison, or a legislative lobbyist
    representing only one lobbyist principal, may not exceed Five
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    Hundred Dollars ($500.00) Fifty Dollars ($50.00); or
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        2. A legislative lobbyist representing more than one lobbyist
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    principal may not exceed One Hundred Dollars ($100.00).
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        Any gift made in accordance with this section shall be reported
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    to the Oklahoma Ethics Commission. The report shall contain the
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    following information:
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        1. The name of the person making the gift;
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        2. The name of the person receiving the gift;
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        3. A description of the gift and its value; and
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        4. The date the gift was presented.
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        SECTION 4. This act shall become effective January 1, 2017.
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
