14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

17	A. All health care facilities that perform mammography
18	examinations shall include in the summary of the mammography report,
19	required by federal law to be provided to a patient, information
20	that identifies the patient's individual breast density
21	classification based on the Breast Imaging Reporting and Data System
22	established by the American College of Radiology. If the facility
23	determines that a patient has heterogeneously or extremely dense

breast tissue, the summary of the mammography report shall include the following notice:

"Your mammogram indicates that you have dense breast tissue. Dense breast tissue is relatively common and is found in more than forty percent (40%) of women. The presence of dense tissue may make it more difficult to detect cancers in the breast and may be associated with an increased risk of breast cancer. We are providing this information to raise your awareness of this important factor and to encourage you to talk with your physician about this and other breast cancer risk factors. Together, you can decide which screening options are right for you. A report of your results was sent to your physician."

Patients who receive diagnostic or screening mammograms may be directed to informative material about breast density. informative material may include the American College of Radiology's most current brochure on the subject of breast density.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
