8	An Act relating to alternative fuels; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Sections 130.14, as renumbered by Section
9	18, Chapter 328, O.S.L. 2014 and as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 181, O.S.L. 2015, 130.16, as
10	renumbered by Section 20, Chapter 328, O.S.L. 2014 and as last amended by Section 4, Chapter 181, O.S.L.
11	2015 and 130.17, as renumbered by Section 21, Chapter 328, O.S.L. 2014 and as last amended by Section 5,
12	Chapter 181, O.S.L. 2015 (40 O.S. Supp. 2015, Sections 142.6, 142.8 and 142.9), which relate to the
13	Alternative Fuels Technician Certification Act; changing selection criteria for certain member of the
14	Committee of Alternative Fuels Technician Examiners; modifying duties of certain officer to the Committee;
15	authorizing the Department of Labor to issue an alternative fuels compression trainee certificate;
16	limiting employment of a trainee; requiring trainee to work under the direct supervision of a certain
17	technician; limiting the number of trainees working with a technician or on a job site; allowing a
18	trainee to engage in certain licensed categories under certain conditions; adding fee for certain
19	certificate and certificate renewal; modifying fee for annual renewal of certain certification; and
20	declaring an emergency.
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23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
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SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 130.14, as
 renumbered by Section 18, Chapter 328, O.S.L. 2014 and as last
 amended by Section 2, Chapter 181, O.S.L. 2015 (40 O.S. Supp. 2015,
 Section 142.6), is amended to read as follows:

Section 142.6 A. There is hereby established the Committee of
Alternative Fuels Technician Examiners which shall consist of eight
(8) members. All members of the Committee shall be residents of
this state.

9 B. Five voting members of the Committee shall be appointed by10 the Commissioner of Labor as follows:

Three members shall be alternative fuels technicians
 selected from a list of names submitted by the State Board of Career
 and Technology Education, with at least one member being an
 alternative fuels equipment technician and at least one member being
 an alternative fuels compression technician;

16 2. One member shall be a person involved in compressed natural 17 gas technology in an oil and/or gas industry; and

One member shall be a person involved in liquefied petroleum
 gas technology in an oil and/or gas industry.

C. Two additional voting members shall be appointed by the Commissioner of Labor, one of whom shall be selected from a list of names submitted by the State Board of Career and Technology Education and shall be an electric vehicle technician, and one of

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1 whom shall be a person involved in manufacturing, conversion, or 2 research in the electric vehicle industry.

D. All members shall each have at least two (2) years of active experience in alternative fuels technology. The terms of the voting members initially appointed to the Committee shall be staggered as follows:

7 1. One alternative fuels technician shall be appointed for a
8 term of two (2) years;

9 2. One alternative fuels technician shall be appointed for a
10 term of three (3) years;

One alternative fuels technician shall be appointed for a
 term of four (4) years;

4. One person involved in compressed natural gas technology in an oil and/or gas industry shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years;

16 5. One person involved in liquefied petroleum gas technology in 17 an oil and/or gas industry shall be appointed for a term of four (4) 18 years;

One electric vehicle technician shall be appointed for a
 term of two (2) years; and

21 7. One person involved in manufacturing, conversion, or 22 research in the electric vehicle industry shall be appointed for a 23 term of three (3) years.

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Thereafter, each voting member of the Committee shall be
 appointed for a term of five (5) years, or until their successors
 are appointed and qualified.

The nonvoting member shall be designated by the Commissioner of Labor to serve as <del>Program Administrator and</del> Recording Secretary to the Committee.

7 E. Vacancies which may occur in the membership of the Committee shall be filled by appointment of the Commissioner of Labor. Each 8 9 person who has been appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve for the 10 remainder of the term for which the member such person succeeds was 11 appointed and until a successor has been appointed and has 12 qualified. Members of the Committee may be removed from office by the Commissioner of Labor for cause in the manner provided by law 13 14 for the removal of officers not subject to impeachment.

15 The Committee shall assist and advise the Commissioner of F. 16 Labor on all matters relating to the formulation of rules and 17 standards in accordance with the Alternative Fuels Technician 18 Certification Act. The Commissioner of Labor or designee shall 19 administer the examinations of applicants for certification as 20 alternative fuels equipment technicians, alternative fuels 21 compression technicians, and electric vehicle technicians provided 22 that such examinations shall be in accordance with the provisions of 23 the Alternative Fuels Technician Certification Act.

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G. All members of the Committee shall be reimbursed for
 expenses incurred while in the performance of their duties in
 accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

4 H. A majority of the total membership of the Committee shall5 constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

6 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 130.16, as 7 renumbered by Section 20, Chapter 328, O.S.L. 2014 and as last 8 amended by Section 4, Chapter 181, O.S.L. 2015 (40 O.S. Supp. 2015, 9 Section 142.8), is amended to read as follows:

Section 142.8 A. The Department of Labor shall issue a certificate as an alternative fuels equipment technician to any person who:

13 1. Has been licensed by the Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas 14 Board and has successfully passed the appropriate examination as 15 provided in the Alternative Fuels Technician Certification Act or 16 has been certified by the Committee as either having successfully 17 passed the appropriate examination or having a valid license or 18 certificate issued by another governmental entity with licensing or 19 certification requirements similar to those provided in the 20 Alternative Fuels Technician Certification Act; and

21 2. Has paid the certification fee and otherwise complied with
22 the provisions of the Alternative Fuels Technician Certification
23 Act.

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B. The Department of Labor shall issue a certificate as an
 alternative fuels compression technician to any person who:

Has successfully passed the appropriate examination as
 provided in the Alternative Fuels Technician Certification Act or
 has been certified by the Committee as having a valid license or
 certificate issued by another governmental entity with licensing or
 certification requirements similar to those provided in the
 Alternative Fuels Technician Certification Act; and

9 2. Has paid the certification fee and otherwise complied with
10 the provisions of the Alternative Fuels Technician Certification
11 Act.

12 C. The Department of Labor shall issue a certificate as an 13 electric vehicle technician to any person who:

Has been certified by the Committee as either having
 successfully passed the appropriate examination or having a valid
 license or certificate issued by another governmental entity with
 licensing or certification requirements similar to those provided in
 the Alternative Fuels Technician Certification Act; and

Has paid the certification fee and otherwise complied with
 the provisions of the Alternative Fuels Technician Certification
 Act.

D. In the case of a company, partnership or corporation engaged in the business of installing, servicing, repairing, modifying or renovating equipment used in the conversion of engines to engines

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1 fueled by alternative fuels, a separate certificate shall be issued by the Department of Labor to that individual company, partnership 2 or corporation. This certificate is for the express purpose of 3 recognizing that the company, partnership or corporation is an 4 authorized alternative fuels conversion business and employs state-5 certified alternative fuels equipment technicians. Any violations 6 7 by a certified alternative fuels equipment technician shall be deemed a violation by the certified company, partnership or 8 9 corporation employing such certified technician. A company, 10 partnership or corporation engaged in the business of installing, servicing, repairing, modifying or renovating equipment used in the 11 12 conversion of engines to engines fueled by alternative fuels shall 13 provide the Department of Labor with proof of liability insurance 14 with limits of not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) 15 general liability.

16 In the case of a company, partnership or corporation engaged Е. 17 in the business of installing, servicing, repairing, modifying or 18 renovating fill stations, a separate certificate shall be issued by 19 the Department of Labor to that individual company, partnership or 20 corporation. This certificate is for the express purpose of 21 recognizing that the company, partnership or corporation is an 22 authorized fill-station installation business and employs state-23 certified alternative fuels compression technicians or electric 24 vehicle technicians. Any violations by a certified alternative

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1 fuels compression technician or electric vehicle technician shall be 2 deemed a violation by the certified company, partnership or corporation employing such certified technician. A company, 3 4 partnership or corporation engaged in the business of installing, 5 servicing, repairing, modifying or renovating fill stations shall provide the Department of Labor with proof of liability insurance 6 7 with limits of not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) 8 general liability.

9 F. In conjunction with subsection A of this section, the 10 Department of Labor shall issue an Alternative Fuels Equipment 11 Installation Certification to any public entity or private company, 12 partnership or corporation that operates commercial, private or 13 public fleets of vehicles and employs ten or more auto service 14 technicians per location. The certification shall be based on the 15 ability of the applicant to provide their own alternative fuels 16 equipment technician training program which shall be certified by 17 the Department of Labor, Committee of Alternative Fuels Technician 18 Examiners. This subsection shall not apply to allow certification 19 of any alternative fuels compression technician training programs.

G. All alternative fuels equipment technician certificates,
alternative fuels compression technician certificates, and electric
vehicle technician certificates shall be nontransferable and it
shall be unlawful for any person certified pursuant to the
provisions of the Alternative Fuels Technician Certification Act to

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loan or allow the use of such certificate by any other person,
 except as specifically provided in the Alternative Fuels Technician
 Certification Act.

4 The standards for the storage and handling of liquefied Η. 5 petroleum gases in the codes adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission pursuant to the Oklahoma Uniform Building 6 7 Code Act shall be the accepted codes and standards for this state. The standards for the installation of compressed natural gas 8 9 vehicular fuel systems adopted by the National Fire Protection 10 Association and published in its Pamphlet No. 52 shall be the 11 accepted standards for this state. The accepted standards for this 12 state for electric vehicle charge stations shall be the codes 13 adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission. The 14 standards for the design, construction, installation, repair, use 15 and inspection of alternative fuel fueling stations, including 16 residential fueling appliances and facilities, in the codes adopted 17 by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission pursuant to the 18 Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission Act shall be the accepted 19 codes and standards for this state. The Commissioner of Labor is 20 authorized, and it shall be the duty of the Commissioner to adopt 21 and promulgate such rules or specifications relating to safety in 22 the manufacture, assembly, sale, installation and use of vehicular 23 alternative fuel systems. The Commissioner of Labor is further

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1 authorized to modify or amend such rules or specifications as he or 2 she deems reasonable and necessary.

3 I. The Department of Labor may issue an alternative fuels 4 trainee certificate to any person who submits a trainee application 5 to the Department within fifteen (15) business days of being hired by a licensed alternative fuels conversion company. An alternative 6 7 fuels trainee shall be employed by a licensed alternative fuels 8 conversion company located in Oklahoma. A trainee shall work under 9 the direct supervision of a licensed alternative fuels equipment 10 technician. There shall be no more than two alternative fuels 11 trainees per licensed alternative fuels equipment technician at any 12 licensed Oklahoma alternative fuels conversion company at any one 13 time. An individual that holds a trainee license may engage in any 14 licensed category pursuant to the Alternative Fuels Technician 15 Certification Act while under the direct supervision of an 16 individual holding the appropriate license in the category of 17 activity being performed.

18J. The Department of Labor may issue an alternative fuels19compression trainee certificate to any person who submits a trainee20application to the Department within fifteen (15) business days of21being hired by a licensed alternative fuels fill-station22installation business. An alternative fuels compression trainee23shall be employed by a licensed alternative fuels fill-station24installation business located in Oklahoma. A trainee shall work

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1	under the direct supervision of a licensed alternative fuels
2	compression technician. There shall be no more than two alternative
3	fuels compression trainees per licensed alternative fuels
4	compression technician at any licensed Oklahoma alternative fuels
5	fill-station installation business or the job site or sites of any
6	such alternative fuels fill-station installation business at any one
7	time. An individual who holds a trainee license may engage in any
8	licensed category pursuant to the Alternative Fuels Technician
9	Certification Act while under the direct supervision of an
10	individual holding the appropriate license in the category of
11	activity being performed.
12	SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 130.17, as
13	renumbered by Section 21, Chapter 328, O.S.L. 2014 and as last
14	amended by Section 5, Chapter 181, O.S.L. 2015 (40 O.S. Supp. 2015,
15	Section 142.9), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 142.9 A. 1. All applications for examination,
17	certification or renewal of certification shall be made in writing
18	to the Department of Labor on forms provided, if necessary, by the
19	Department of Labor. All applications shall be accompanied by the
20	appropriate fee.
21	2. If a person holds a valid Class I Dealer Permit properly
22	issued by the Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board, pursuant to
23	Section 420.4 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the requirements
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of this section for certification or renewal of certification shall
 not be required.
