Whoever, having been admitted to bail for 16 appearance before any district court in the State of Oklahoma, (1) 17 incurs a forfeiture of the bail and willfully fails to surrender 18 himself or herself within thirty (30) days following the date of 19 such forfeiture, or (2) willfully fails to comply with the terms of 20 his or her personal recognizance, shall be quilty of a felony and 21 shall be fined not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or 22 imprisoned not more than two (2) years, or both; provided, that if 23 the person used the services of a bail bondsman for the bail for
