13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.7 of Title 57, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Effective July 1, 2019, all correctional officers of the
18 Department of Corrections who are assigned to the following
19 facilities:

- 4 9. Jess Dunn Correctional Center;

- 6 11. John H. Lilley Correctional Center;
- 7 12. Joseph Harp Correctional Center;
- 8 13. Kate Barnard Correctional Center;
- 9 14. Lawton Community Corrections Center;
- 10 15. Lexington Assessment and Reception Center;
- 11 16. Mabel Bassett Correctional Center;
- 12 17. Mack Alford Correctional Center;
- 13 18. North Fork Correctional Center;
- 14 19. Northeast Oklahoma Correctional Center;
- 15 20. Oklahoma City Community Corrections Center;
- 16 21. Oklahoma State Penitentiary;
- 17 22. Oklahoma State Reformatory;
- 18 23. Union City Community Corrections Center; and
- 19 24. William S. Key Correctional Center,

20 and who were employed by the state on the last working day of June
21 2019 and previously graduated from the correctional officer training
22 program of the Department shall be awarded an increase of Two
23 Dollars (\$2.00) per hour over their current hourly wage.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
