13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 2021, Section 604, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 604. The Director of the Department of Human Services
17	shall, within the constraints of funding appropriated to the
18	Department, maintain a Family Support Program for children with
19	severe developmental disabilities who reside in their family homes
20	in accordance with the following criteria:
21	1. The family member resides with the family;
22	2. The family resides in the State of Oklahoma;
23	3. The gross adjusted income of the family for the year
24	immediately preceding the date of application for the assistance did

1 not exceed Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00) by seventy-five
2 percent (75%) of the amount as allowed by Public Law No. 104-193;

4. The family is headed by a biological parent, adoptive
parent, or legal guardian of the eligible family member; provided,
however, that if the eligible family member lives with an adoptive
parent or parents who already receive adoption subsidy from any
source on behalf of the applicant, the family cannot receive family
support assistance authorized by this section; and

9 5. The family or family member does not receive Medicaid Home10 and Community-based Waiver Services.

11 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 2021, Section 606, is 12 amended to read as follows:

Section 606. If an application for family support assistance pursuant to the Oklahoma Family Support Act is approved by the Department of Human Services and Developmental Disabilities Services Division:

17 1. A family support assistance payment shall be paid to the 18 parent or legal guardian on behalf of a family member and shall be 19 considered a benefit to the family member;

20 2. The family support assistance payment shall be used to meet
 21 the special needs of the family associated with the family member.
 22 Except as otherwise provided in the Oklahoma Family Support Act,
 23 this assistance payment is intended to complement, not to supplant,

23	4. Parents or legal guardians, whose income is at or below the	

1 payment amount in paragraph 3 for a flat monthly payment of Four 2 Hundred Dollars (\$400.00).

5. Increases to this amount shall be determined annually by legislative appropriation. In addition, the parent or legal guardian of a family member who is in an out-of-home placement at the time of application may receive a one-time, lump-sum advance payment of twice the monthly family support assistance amount for the purpose of meeting the special needs of the family to prepare for the placement or return of the family member to in-home care.

10 <u>4. 6.</u> The parent or legal guardian who receives a family 11 support assistance payment shall report, in writing, at least the 12 following information to the Department:

- a. not less than annually, a statement and any supporting
   documentation requested by the Department that the
   family support assistance payment was used to meet the
   special needs of the family,
- b. immediately, if the parent or legal guardian requests
  termination of the family support assistance,
- c. immediately, upon the occurrence of any event listed
  in Section 7 607 of this act title.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
