1 counties in which the most evictions occur and to indigent tenants who are disproportionately at risk of eviction.

- B. For purposes of this section, "indigent" means any person who, at any stage of a court proceeding, is:
- 1. Receiving one of the following types of public assistance: temporary assistance for needy families, aged, blind, or disabled assistance benefits, SoonerCare, pregnant women assistance benefits, poverty-related veterans' benefits, food stamps or food stamp benefits transferred electronically, refugee resettlement benefits, Medicaid, or supplemental security income; or
- 2. Receiving an annual income, after taxes, of two-hundred percent (200%) or less of the current federally established poverty level.
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
