AMENDATORY 12 amended to read as follows: 13 Section 1000.2 A. The Construction Industries Board is hereby 14 re-created to continue until July 1, 2023 2026, in accordance with 15 the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The Board shall regulate 16 the plumbing, electrical and mechanical trades, the building and 17 construction inspectors, and the roofing contractors through the 18 powers and duties set forth in the Construction Industries Board Act 19 and in the respective licensing or registration acts for such 20 trades, or as otherwise provided by law. 21 B. 1. Beginning July 1, 2013, the Board shall be composed of 22 seven (7) members appointed by the Governor with the advice and 23 consent of the Oklahoma State Senate, as follows:

- a. two members shall have at least ten (10) years'
 experience in the plumbing trade, of which one shall
 be a plumbing contractor and one shall be a journeyman
 plumber,
 b. two members shall have at least ten (10) years'
 - b. two members shall have at least ten (10) years' experience in the electrical trade, of which one shall be an electrical contractor and one shall be a journeyman electrician,
 - c. two members shall have at least ten (10) years' experience in the mechanical trade, of which one shall be a mechanical contractor and one shall be a mechanical journeyman, and
 - d. one member shall have at least ten (10) years' experience as a building and construction inspector.
 - 2. Members shall be appointed for staggered terms of four (4) years, as designated by the Governor. Members shall continue in office until a successor is appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall fill all vacancies and unexpired terms in the same manner as the original appointment of the member whose position is to be filled. A member may be removed by the Governor at any time.
