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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
19	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
20	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Kelsey Smith
21	Act".
22	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2861 of Title 63, unless there
24	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Upon request of a law enforcement agency, a wireless service
provider shall provide call location information concerning the
telecommunications device of the user to the requesting law
enforcement agency in order to respond to a call for emergency
services or in an emergency situation that involves the risk of
death or serious physical harm.

B. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
nothing in this section prohibits a wireless service provider from
establishing protocols by which the provider could voluntarily
disclose call location information.

11 C. No cause of action shall lie in any court against any 12 wireless service provider, its officers, employees, agents or other 13 specified persons for providing call location information while 14 acting in good faith and in accordance with the provisions of this 15 section.

16 D. 1. All wireless service providers registered to do business 17 in the state or submitting to the jurisdiction of the state and all 18 resellers of wireless telecommunications services shall submit their 19 emergency contact information to the Oklahoma State Bureau of 20 Investigation in order to facilitate requests from a law enforcement 21 agency for call location information in accordance with this 22 section. This contact information shall be submitted annually by 23 June 15 or immediately upon any change in contact information.

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2. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall maintain a database containing emergency contact information for all wireless service providers registered to do business in the state and shall make the information immediately available upon request to all public safety answering points in the state. Е. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall promulgate rules as necessary to fulfill the requirements of this section no later than January 1, 2017. SECTION 3.
