6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to health care funding; creating
8 Primary Care Stabilization Revolving Fund; providing
9 for apportionment of revenues; authorizing
10 expenditures by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority;
11 authorizing Oklahoma Health Care Authority to apply
12 for certain waivers; providing for codification;
13 providing an effective date; and declaring an
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5006.5 of Title 63, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
20 fund for the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to be designated the
21 "Primary Care Stabilization Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a
22 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
23 consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority
24 from monies apportioned thereto for purposes of this section from
appropriations, gifts or donations.

1 B. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
2 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Health
3 Care Authority by reimbursement contracts to health centers
4 authorized under Section 330 of the Public Health Service Act, and
5 incorporated in the State of Oklahoma for the provision of primary
6 health care services to uninsured patients as regulated by 42 C.F.R.
7 Chapter 1 part 51c and all applicable current and future subparts
8 and sections.

9 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is hereby authorized to
10 pursue from the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services
11 an application for any waivers or any state plan amendments required
12 to amend the state Medicaid plan to support the purposes of the
13 section.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
