6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to criminal procedure; providing that  
8 judges be suspended from hearing certain cases if  
9 bound over for trial for a criminal offense;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 264.1 of Title 22, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 If a judge is ordered to answer for a criminal offense pursuant  
17 to Section 264 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the judge shall  
18 be suspended from hearing any criminal cases until final resolution  
19 of the case for which the judge has been charged.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
