7 An Act relating to judicial compensation; rejecting  
8 and amending judicial salaries established by the  
9 Board on Judicial Compensation; establishing increase  
10 for certain categories of judges; maintaining salary  
11 for certain categories of judges and justices;  
12 establishing date of implementation; providing for  
13 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 Pursuant to the authority provided in Section 3.2 of Title 20 of  
18 the Oklahoma Statutes to reject judicial salaries established by the  
19 Board on Judicial Compensation, the Oklahoma Legislature hereby  
20 rejects the Final Report of the Board on Judicial Compensation  
21 issued on September 19, 2023.

22 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
23 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

1 The Oklahoma Legislature hereby amends judicial salaries to take  
2 effect July 1, 2024. The amended salary schedule provided for in  
3 this section provides a salary increase of seven percent (7.0%)  
4 above the salary levels existing during fiscal year 2024 for  
5 positions listed as follows; all other judicial salaries shall  
6 remain at the levels that existed as of January 1, 2024.

- 7 District Judges
- 8 Associate District Judges
- 9 Special District Judges

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
