12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 12, Chapter 230, O.S.L.
14	2015 (59 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 353.18A), is amended to read as
15	follows:
16	Section 353.18A A. Supportive personnel may perform certain
17	tasks in the practice of pharmacy if such personnel perform the
18	tasks in compliance with rules promulgated by the State Board of
19	Pharmacy.
20	B. All pharmacy technicians shall perform their tasks under the
21	immediate and direct supervision of pharmacists licensed by the
22	Board. Each supervising pharmacist on duty at a pharmacy shall be
23	allowed to supervise not more than four pharmacy technicians.

<u>C.</u> 1. No person shall serve as a pharmacy technician without
 first procuring a permit from the Board.

2. An application for an initial or renewal pharmacy technician
permit issued pursuant to the provisions of this subsection shall be
submitted to the Board and provide any other information deemed
relevant by the Board.

An application for an initial or renewal permit shall be
accompanied by a permit fee not to exceed Seventy Five Dollars
(\$75.00) for each period of one (1) year. A permit issued pursuant
to this subsection shall be valid for a period to be determined by
the Board.

4. Every permitted pharmacy technician who fails to complete a renewal form and remit the required renewal fee to the Board by the fifteenth day after the expiration of the permit shall pay a late fee to be fixed by the Board.

16 5. A pharmacy technician permit shall be cancelled thirty (30)
17 days after expiration.

18 6. A person may obtain reinstatement of a cancelled pharmacy
19 technician permit by making application, paying a reinstatement fee,
20 and satisfactorily completing other requirements set by the Board.
21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
