3 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
4 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
5 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred
6 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall, under the direction of
7 the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to various Councils
8 of Government to support substate planning.

9 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
10 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
11 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Thirty-six
12 Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-one Dollars (\$36,221.00) shall, under
13 the direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to
14 support the functions of community action agencies.

15 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
16 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
17 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred
18 Eighty-three Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-four Dollars
19 (\$183,874.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive Director
20 of Commerce, be allocated to community action agencies to support
21 Head Start programs.

22 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
23 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
24 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Sixty-four

1 Thousand Two Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$64,217.00) shall, under the
2 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to the
3 RX for Oklahoma Prescription Assistance program.

4 SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
5 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
6 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Eight Hundred
7 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$850,000.00) shall, under the direction of
8 the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to support Small
9 Business Development Centers.

10 SECTION 7. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
11 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
12 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Ten Million
13 Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive
14 Director of Commerce, be allocated to help fund at Rogers State
15 University a new Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics
16 (STEM) building.

17 SECTION 8. Appropriations made by this act, not including
18 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25) or may be
20 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026 (hereafter FY-26).
21 Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June 30,
22 2025, and must be expended by November 15, 2025. Any funds
23 remaining after November 15, 2025, and not budgeted for FY-26, shall
24 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal

1 year. Funds budgeted for FY-26 may be encumbered only through June
2 30, 2026. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2026, shall lapse
3 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
4 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
5 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-25, and not required to pay
6 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-26, after
7 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
8 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
9 from the FY-25 budget work program and after such revision has been
10 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

11 SECTION 9. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

12 SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
