7	An Act relating to schools; creating the Fifth Day School Partnership Act; authorizing certain school
8	districts to provide additional instruction through Partnership; providing for virtual instruction taught
9	by student teachers; requiring joint project between State Department of Education and certain
10	institutions of higher learning; providing for curriculum development and approval; directing
11	identification and selection of student teachers; proscribing instruction time for attendance purposes;
12	requiring Department to promulgate rules to implement act; providing for codification; and providing an
13	effective date.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-111.1 of Title 70, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Fifth Day
21	School Partnership Act".
22	B. School districts that adopt and implement an extended-day
23	schedule which allows for four (4) days of school per week may
24	

provide one additional day of instruction for students through the
 Fifth Day School Partnership.

C. The Fifth Day School Partnership shall offer educational
instruction to students virtually and shall be taught by student
teachers as part of their nonsalaried internships.

6 The Partnership shall be a joint project between the State D. 7 Department of Education and institutions of higher learning approved by the State Board of Education for teacher training. Curriculum 8 9 for the virtual instruction Partnership shall be developed by the 10 Department and approved by the Board. Institutions of higher 11 learning approved by the Board for teacher training shall identify 12 and select student teachers in their institutions to instruct 13 students virtually.

E. School districts that participate in the Partnership shall not count the instruction time for attendance purposes in meeting the school year requirements provided in Section 1-109 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

18 F. The Department shall promulgate rules necessary to implement19 the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
