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9 An Act relating to the State Capitol Building;
10 amending 7 O.S. 2011, Section 73, which relates to
11 vending facilities; providing exception for areas of
the State Capitol Building; and providing an
effective date.

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 7 O.S. 2011, Section 73, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 73. A. It shall be the duty of the board of county
18 commissioners of each county and the governing boards of all state
19 institutions, state agencies and state or county public trust
20 authorities, with regard to the premises of county or state property
21 under their respective jurisdictions or the premises of property
22 leased by them in whole or in part, to give priority to vending
23 facilities operated by licensed blind operators and established by
24 the State Department of Rehabilitation Services. Governing boards

1 shall observe such priority by entering into an agreement with the
2 Department. Operators shall be licensed by the Department.

3 B. Governing boards shall make available free of any charge,
4 fee, assessment or commission on sales adequate space with
5 sufficient electrical, plumbing, heating and ventilation outlets for
6 the operation of a vending facility on satisfactory sites.

7 Governing boards shall provide free of any charge, fee, assessment
8 or commission on sales the use of utilities needed to operate a
9 vending facility.

10 C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the
11 operation of fairgrounds, exposition centers, trade/consumer show
12 facilities, pari-mutuel horse racing facilities as licensed by the
13 Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission, parks, golf courses ~~or~~, hospitals
14 operated by county trust authorities or the State Capitol Building
15 and grounds; provided, that vending machines within the State
16 Capitol Building shall be subject to the provisions of subsections A
17 and B of this section.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
