7                                   AS INTRODUCED

8                   An Act relating to vulnerable adults; requiring  
9                   Office of the Attorney General to promulgate rules to  
10                  establish and maintain certain registry by certain  
11                  date; requiring registry to contain certain  
12                  information; providing for codification; and  
13                  providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15                  SECTION 1.        NEW LAW        A new section of law to be codified  
16                  in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-111.1 of Title 43A, unless  
17                  there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18                  A.    On or before January 1, 2019, the Office of the Attorney  
19                  General shall promulgate rules to establish and maintain the  
20                  Vulnerable Adult Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation Registry,  
21                  accessible to the public in an electronic format, to address:

22                  1.    A procedure for recording individuals on the registry who  
23                  have been convicted of perpetrating abuse, neglect or exploitation  
24                  of a vulnerable adult;

- 1           2. A procedure to provide notice and an opportunity for review  
2 prior to recording an individual on the registry; and  
3           3. Disclosure requirements for information on the registry.  
4           B. The registry shall include, but not be limited to:  
5           1. The full name of the individual;  
6           2. Information necessary to identify the individual;  
7           3. A description of the findings of abuse, neglect or  
8 exploitation by the Office of the Attorney General; and  
9           4. The date the individual was listed on the registry.

10           SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
