15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

16 "An Act relating to vulnerable adults; requiring
17 Office of the Attorney General to establish and
18 maintain certain report by certain date; requiring
19 registry to contain certain information; providing
20 for codification; and providing an effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-111.1 of Title 43A, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. On or before January 1, 2019, the Office of the Attorney
2 General shall promulgate and maintain the Vulnerable Adult Abuse,
3 Neglect and Exploitation Report, accessible to the public on the
4 Internet in an electronic format that is easily and readily
5 searchable.

6 B. The report created in subsection A of this section shall be
7 maintained by the Office of the Attorney General and shall include a
8 list of defendants who have been prosecuted by the Office of the
9 Attorney General and have been found guilty by a court of law for
10 abuse, exploitation or neglect of elderly or vulnerable adults in
11 the preceding twelve (12) months. The report shall be provided to
12 the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the
13 President Pro Tempore of the Senate on an annual basis beginning
14 January 31, 2019. The report shall include, but not be limited to:

- 15 1. The name of the defendant;
- 16 2. The crime for which the defendant was convicted;
- 17 3. A description of the findings of abuse, neglect or
18 exploitation by the Office of the Attorney General, including the
19 circumstances surrounding the abuse;
- 20 4. The date of conviction or the date that a plea of guilty or
21 nolo contendere was accepted by the court;
- 22 5. The relationship of the defendant to the victim; and
- 23 6. The county where the offense or offenses occurred.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018."

15 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-111.1 of Title 43A, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. On or before January 1, 2019, the Office of the Attorney
19 General shall promulgate rules to establish and maintain the
20 Vulnerable Adult Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation Registry,
21 accessible to the public in an electronic format, to address:

22 1. A procedure for recording individuals on the registry who
23 have been convicted of perpetrating abuse, neglect or exploitation
24 of a vulnerable adult;

1 2. A procedure to provide notice and an opportunity for review
2 prior to recording an individual on the registry; and

3 3. Disclosure requirements for information on the registry.

4 B. The registry shall include, but not be limited to:

5 1. The full name of the individual;

6 2. Information necessary to identify the individual;

7 3. A description of the findings of abuse, neglect or
8 exploitation by the Office of the Attorney General; and

9 4. The date the individual was listed on the registry.

10 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
