14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 139.111 of Title 17, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. For purposes of applying for and participating in the
18	federal Schools and Libraries E-Rate Program administered by the
19	Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC), academic and
20	research libraries as defined in subsection C of this section shall
21	be considered libraries for purposes of the definition of libraries
22	and under the requirements for schools and libraries as set forth in

the Schools and Libraries E-Rate Program.

- B. Academic and research libraries as defined in subsection C of this section shall be eligible to seek assistance from the Oklahoma Department of Libraries for purposes of applying for Schools and Libraries E-Rate Program discounts through the USAC which are available to schools and libraries.
- C. As used in this section, "academic libraries and research libraries" means a private library, private museum or volunteer fire department that:
- 1. Operates as a nonprofit corporation which is exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3);
 - 2. Is available for continuing education classes; and

3. Is open to the public for a minimum of ten (10) hours per week with at least three computers available for use by the public.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
