8	An Act relating to school elections; amending 26 O.S.
9	2011, Section 13A-110, as amended by Section 8, Chapter 380, O.S.L. 2015 (26 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section
10	13A-110), which relates to vacancies on boards of education; providing for the filling of certain
11	vacancies on the board of education by appointment; allowing the appointment of persons who do not reside
12	in certain districts; requiring appointed persons to reside in the school district and meet other
13	eligibility qualifications; limiting service; and requiring certain boards of education to give
14	preference to certain persons.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 13A-110, as
18	amended by Section 8, Chapter 380, O.S.L. 2015 (26 O.S. Supp. 2015,
19	Section 13A-110), is amended to read as follows:
20	Section 13A-110. A. Vacancies for members of the board of
21	education of every school district or technology center school
22	district shall be filled by appointment by the board. Persons
23	B. Except as provided in subsection D of this section, persons
24	appointed to fill such vacancies in the first half of the term of

1 office for the board position shall serve only until the next succeeding election, at which time the office which they hold shall 2 3 be placed on the ballot for the balance of the unexpired term. Vacancies filled by appointment following the delivery of the 4 5 resolution calling for regular elections to the secretary of the county election board shall be filled until the regular elections 6 the following year. Persons elected to fill unexpired terms shall 7 begin those terms at the next regular meeting of the board of 9 education following the election. Persons appointed to fill such 10 vacancies after the first half of the term of office for the board 11 position shall serve for the balance of the unexpired term.

C. Except as provided in subsection D of this section, no person shall be appointed to a board of education who does not meet the eligibility qualifications needed to be a candidate for such position as provided for in Sections Section 13A-106 of this title and Sections 5-110, 5-110.1 and 5-113 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

D. If after the filing period is closed no candidate for an open position on a board of education of a school district has filed and therefore a vacancy is created, the vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the board. Persons appointed to fill such vacancies shall not be required to reside in the board or election district but shall be required to reside in the school district and to meet the other eligibility qualifications needed to be a candidate for

1	the position as provided in Section 13A-106 of this title and
2	Sections 5-110, 5-110.1 and 5-113 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma
3	Statutes. Persons appointed to fill vacancies as provided for in
4	this subsection shall be eligible to serve only for the balance of
5	the term.
6	$\underline{\mathtt{E.}}$ If the board of education does not fill the vacancy by
7	appointment within sixty (60) days of the date the board declared
8	the seat vacant, the board of education shall call a special
9	election to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term. The special
10	election shall be called on a date established by subsection B of
11	Section 3-101 of this title, and the special filing period shall be
12	scheduled as required in subsection D of Section 13A-109 of this
13	title.
