AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to contracts; prohibiting certain tip and gratuity practices; requiring express consent; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 520 of Title 15, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No entity engaging in business in the state of Oklahoma may charge a tip or gratuity for services rendered without the consumer's express consent, either in writing, including electronic signature, or verbally given.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
