B. A dealer shall indemnify a warrantor for any money paid or costs incurred by a warrantor in connection with a claim or cause of action asserted against the warrantor to the extent that payment or costs incurred are based on the negligence or intentional misconduct of the dealer. A dealer shall not limit the obligation to indemnify described in this subsection by agreement with the warrantor. warrantor shall provide a dealer with a copy of any claim or complaint in which an allegation described in this subsection is made within ten (10) days after receiving the claim or complaint.
