6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,
8 Section 4-101, which relates to voter registration;
9 modifying persons entitled to become registered
10 voters; adding exception; and providing an effective
11 date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-101, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 4-101. Every person who is a qualified elector as
16 defined by Section 1 of Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution
17 shall be entitled to become a registered voter in the precinct of
18 his residence, with the following exceptions:

19 1. Persons convicted of a felony shall be ineligible to
20 register for a period of time equal to the time prescribed in the
21 judgment and sentence.

22 2. Persons convicted of violating any provision of the Uniform
23 Controlled Dangerous Substances Act shall be ineligible to register
24 for a period of five (5) years.

1 3. Any person who has been adjudged to be an incapacitated
2 person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the
3 Oklahoma Statutes, shall be ineligible to register to vote. When
4 such incapacitated person has been adjudged to be no longer
5 incapacitated such person shall be eligible to become a registered
6 voter. The provisions of this paragraph shall not prohibit any
7 person adjudged to be a partially incapacitated person as such term
8 is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes
9 from being eligible to register to vote unless the order adjudging
10 the person to be partially incapacitated restricts such persons from
11 being eligible to register to vote.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
