17	shall be entitled to become a registered voter in the precinct of
18	his residence, with the following exceptions:
19	1. Persons convicted of a felony shall be ineligible to
20	register for a period of time equal to the time prescribed in the
21	judgment and sentence.
22	2. Persons convicted of violating any provision of the Uniform
23	Controlled Dangerous Substances Act shall be ineligible to register
24	for a period of five (5) years.

Any person who has been adjudged to be an incapacitated person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be ineligible to register to vote. such incapacitated person has been adjudged to be no longer incapacitated such person shall be eligible to become a registered The provisions of this paragraph shall not prohibit any voter. person adjudged to be a partially incapacitated person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes from being eligible to register to vote unless the order adjudging the person to be partially incapacitated restricts such persons from being eligible to register to vote.
