23	2. "Towing service" means any act which consists of towing or
24	moving a motor vehicle from one place to another under other than
∠ 1	its own power.

- B. No insurer may consider claims for towing services or emergency road service for purposes of determining whether to cancel, refuse to renew, or increase the premium of a personal auto insurance policy regardless of whether such coverage is included in the policy or is an endorsement to the policy.
- C. Nothing in this section shall prohibit an insurer from cancelling, refusing to renew, or increasing the premium of the towing services or emergency road service coverage of an insured if, within a consecutive twelve-month period, the insured:
- 1. Files more than three claims for towing services for any one covered personal motor vehicle or files more than five aggregate claims for towing services for all of the insured's personal motor vehicles which are covered by the insurer; or
- 2. Files more than three claims for emergency road service for any one covered personal motor vehicle or files more than five aggregate claims for emergency road service for all of the insured's personal motor vehicles which are covered by the insurer.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
