11 An Act relating to the State Department of Health;
12 creating the Barbara Weber Amyotrophic Lateral
13 Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program; placing the program at
14 a certain agency; providing purpose; requiring
15 certain reports; establishing the Barbara Weber
16 Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program
17 Revolving Fund; establishing fund nature; authorizing
18 certain budgeting and expenditure of funds for
19 certain purposes; providing for codification;
20 providing an effective date; and declaring an
21 emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-580 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Barbara Weber
Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program".

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-580.1 of Title 63, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 There is hereby created the Barbara Weber Amyotrophic Lateral
5 Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program which shall be administered by the
6 State Department of Health. The program shall grant funds to
7 support research, being conducted in Oklahoma, for Amyotrophic
8 Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) and for programs that help support Oklahoma
9 residents caring for a family member afflicted with ALS. Beginning
10 July 1, 2025, the State Department of Health shall provide an annual
11 report to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
12 Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State
13 Senate, Appropriations and Budget Chair of the Oklahoma House of
14 Representatives, and the Appropriations Chair of the Oklahoma State
15 Senate that includes, but is not limited to, how many grants have
16 been awarded during the fiscal year, which entities the grants have
17 been awarded to, and for what purposes the funds are supporting.

18 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-580.2 of Title 63, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 There is hereby created in the Oklahoma State Treasury a
22 revolving fund for the State Department of Health to be designated
23 the "Barbara Weber Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program
24 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject

1 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
2 by the State Department of Health from appropriations, donations,
3 grants, or other sources of funding specifically designated for
4 deposit to the Barbara Weber Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS)
5 Grant Program Revolving Fund. All monies accruing to the credit of
6 said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended
7 by the State Department of Health for the purpose of the Barbara
8 Weber Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program.
9 Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by
10 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with
11 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
12 approval and payment.

13 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

14 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
