7	An Act relating to alcoholic beverages; creating craft distiller licenses, craft distiller self-		
8	distribution licenses, craft distiller spirit lounge licenses and spirit lounge self-distribution		
9	licenses; providing for authority pursuant to said licenses; defining terms; establishing annual license		
10	fees; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.		
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified		
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-103.1 of Title 37A, unless		
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:		
18	A. A craft distiller license shall authorize the holder thereof		
19	to:		
20	1. Manufacture, bottle, package and store spirits produced by		
21	the licensee on licensed premises;		
22	2. Sell spirits in this state to licensed wholesalers and		
23	holders of retail licenses and to sell spirits outside this state to		
24	qualified persons;		

1 3. Serve free samples of spirits produced only by the licensee 2 to visitors twenty-one (21) years of age and older. For purposes of this paragraph, no visitor may sample more than a total of three (3) 3 4 fluid ounces of spirits per day. The distiller shall restrict the 5 distribution and consumption of samples of spirits to an area within the licensed premises designated by the distiller. A current floor 6 7 plan that includes the designated sampling area shall be on file with the ABLE Commission. No visitor under twenty-one (21) years of 8 9 age shall be permitted to enter the designated sampling area when 10 samples are being distributed and consumed. Samples of spirits 11 served by a distiller under this paragraph shall not be considered a 12 sale of spirits within the meaning of Article XXVIII-A of the 13 Oklahoma Constitution or Section 1-103 of Title 37A of the Oklahoma 14 Statutes; provided, such samples of spirits shall be considered 15 removed or withdrawn from the distillery for use or consumption 16 within the meaning of Section 5-110 of Title 37A of the Oklahoma 17 Statutes for excise tax determination and reporting requirements. 18 Sampling may only occur between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 19 a.m.;

4. Sell spirits produced by the licensee for either on-premises
or off-premises consumption to consumers on the distillery premises
or on premises located contiguous thereto;

23 5. Sell spirits at public events such as trade shows or
24 festivals;

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6. Purchase wine and beer in retail containers from the holder
 of a wholesaler license or as specifically provided by law;

3 7. Sell, offer for sale and possess beer and wine for on-4 premises consumption; and

8. Operate spirit lounges pursuant to Section 2 of this act.

B. A craft distiller self-distribution license shall authorize
a holder of a craft distiller license to distribute spirts produced
only by such licensee to holders of retail liquor licenses, retail
spirits licenses, mixed beverage licenses, beer and wine licenses,
caterer licenses, special event licenses, public event licenses,
charitable auction licenses and brewpub licenses.

C. A craft distiller shall elect whether to distribute through 12 13 a distributor or self-distribute in a subject territory; provided, 14 however, a craft distiller shall not be permitted to elect to do 15 both simultaneously in a subject territory. The election shall be 16 made through notice to the ABLE Commission. Any changes to the 17 election shall require immediate notification to the ABLE Commission 18 before the change in election shall take effect. A craft distiller 19 that elects to self-distribute in multiple territories shall only be 20 required to have one craft distiller self-distribution license.

D. If a craft distiller elects to market wine and beer, the craft distiller shall also be required to obtain a manufacturer's license and comply with the laws and ABLE Commission rules pertaining to both licenses.

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E. As used in this section, "craft distiller" means a distillery that does not annually produce for sale more than one hundred thousand (100,000) proof gallons of spirits as reported to the United States Department of the Treasury Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau.

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-103.2 of Title 37A, unless 8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 A. A craft distiller spirit lounge license shall authorize a10 craft distiller to:

Manufacture, bottle, package and store spirits on the
 licensed premises;

13 2. Sell spirits produced by the licensee for either on-premises
14 or off-premises consumption to consumers on the distillery premises
15 or premises located contiguous thereto;

16 3. Sell spirits at public events such as trade shows or 17 festivals;

18 4. Hold a mixed beverage license, beer and wine license or19 caterer license; and

20 5. Hold a craft distillery self-distribution license.

B. A spirit lounge self-distribution license shall authorize a
holder of a lounge distribution license to distribute spirits
produced only by said licensee pursuant to a spirit lounge operated
by an entity which has common owners with said spirit lounge

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licensee, regardless of which place of business distills the
 spirits.

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C. As used in this section:

1. "Common owners" means that the owners at each place of
business or entity together own more than fifty percent (50%) of the
interest in each place of business or entity that holds a type of
license listed in this subsection;

8 2. "Craft distiller" means a distillery that does not annually 9 produce for sale more than one hundred thousand (100,000) proof 10 gallons of spirits as reported to the United States Department of 11 the Treasury Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau; and

3. "Spirit lounge" means a licensed establishment operated on
the premises of, or on premises located contiguous to, a craft
distiller that prepares and serves food and beverages, including
alcoholic beverages, for on-premises consumption.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-101.1 of Title 37A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The annual license fees for licenses issued pursuant to Sections and 2 of this act shall be as follows:

22	2.	Craft distiller self-distribution license	\$750.00
23	3.	Spirit lounge license	\$75.00
24	4.	Spirit lounge self-distribution license	\$750.00

1	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective upon the passage of
2	a vote of the people of a constitutional amendment authorizing the
3	sale of spirits to consumers.
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
