10	An Act relating to mental health workforce
11	development; amending Section 1, Chapter 112, O.S.L. 2023 (63 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 3278.1), which
12	relates to Oklahoma State University Medical Authority Behavioral Health Workforce Development
13	Fund; creating a revolving fund for the University Hospitals Authority and Trust; providing purpose of
14	pilot program; and declaring an emergency.
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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 112, O.S.L.
18	2023 (63 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 3278.1), is amended to read as
19	follows:
20	Section 3278.1 A. There is hereby created in the State
21	Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma State University Medical
22	Authority to be designated the "Oklahoma State University Medical
23	Authority Behavioral Health Workforce Development Fund". The fund
24	shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,

1 and shall consist of appropriated revenues and private endowments. 2 All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma State 3 4 University Medical Authority for the purpose of designing and 5 implementing a pilot program at behavioral health facilities, the 6 purpose of which is to provide for behavioral health workforce 7 development and access to behavioral health professionals as 8 provided by law. The purpose of the pilot program includes, but is 9 not limited to, bed conversion and new beds; renovations at 10 behavioral health facilities to accommodate new licensed acute or 11 residential treatment beds; reallocation of beds from adult acute to 12 child/adolescent acute beds; relocation assistance for licensed 1.3 behavioral health staff currently living out of state; upskilling 14 existing behavioral health workforce; adding new psychiatric 15 residents psychiatric and psychological residencies, internships and 16 post-doctoral training programs; providing social work scholarships; 17 providing mental health nursing scholarships; creating one-time 18 private-sector workforce innovation grants; providing licensure 19 preparation assistance; and creating a behavioral health trauma fund 20 for intensive home and community-based services. Expenditures from 21 the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer 22 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the 23 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and 24 payment.

B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
fund for the University Hospitals Authority and Trust to be
designated the "University Hospitals Authority and Trust Behavioral
Health Workforce Development Fund". The fund shall be a continuing
fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of
appropriated revenues and private endowments. All monies accruing
to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be
budgeted and expended by the University Hospitals Authority and
Trust for the purpose of designing and implementing a pilot program
at behavioral health facilities, the purpose of which is to provide
for behavioral health workforce development and access to behavioral
health professionals as provided by law. The purpose of the pilot
program includes, but is not limited to, bed conversion and new
beds; renovations at behavioral health facilities to accommodate new
licensed acute or residential treatment beds; reallocation of beds
from adult acute to child/adolescent acute beds; relocation
assistance for licensed behavioral health staff currently living out
of state; upskilling existing behavioral health workforce; adding
new psychiatric and psychological residencies, internships and post-
doctoral training programs; providing social work scholarships;
providing mental health nursing scholarships; creating one-time
private-sector workforce innovation grants; providing licensure
preparation assistance; and creating a behavioral health trauma fund
for intensive home and community-hased services. Expenditures from

1	the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
2	against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the
3	Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and
4	payment.
5	B. C. The Oklahoma State University Medical Authority and the
6	University Hospitals Authority and Trust shall prepare a report for
7	the Legislature on the results of the first year of funding,
8	including the number of professionals retained and recruited, and
9	the expected benefits of the program. The report shall be delivered
10	to relevant health care committee and appropriations subcommittee
11	chairs following the first full year of implementation.
12	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
