16	Program, a person shall:
17	1. Qualify financially for Medicaid;
18	2. Be sixty-five (65) years of age or older or be a physically
19	disabled adult as determined by the Social Security Administration,
20	age twenty-one (21) years or older without mental retardation or
21	cognitive impairment;
22	3. Be determined to meet the nursing facility institutional
23	level of care by the <del>Aging Services Division of the Department of</del>
24	Human Services Oklahoma Health Care Authority;

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        4. Reside in his or her own home or a family member's home; and
        5. Have needs that can be safely met with waiver services and
