16	Section 56-1017.3 To be eligible for the ADvantage Waiver
17	Program, a person shall:
18	1. Qualify financially for Medicaid;
19	2. Be sixty-five (65) years of age or older or be a physically
20	disabled adult as determined by the Social Security Administration,
21	age twenty-one (21) years or older without mental retardation or
22	cognitive impairment;
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1	3. Be determined to meet the nursing facility institutional
2	level of care by the Aging Services Division of the Department of
3	Human Services Oklahoma Health Care Authority;
4	4. Reside in his or her own home or a family member's home; and
5	5. Have needs that can be safely met with waiver services and
6	family or community supports.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
