NEW LAW 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4019.1 of Title 69, unless there 19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 Whenever the Department of Transportation proposes a project 21 that requires a public notice and comment period, the Department 22 shall implement a system for the third-party monitoring of public 23

comments received on such projects. The third-party monitor shall

regularly collect, analyze, and report on public comments submitted

for proposed projects. The Department shall take reasonable steps to ensure that the third-party monitoring process complies with applicable data protection and privacy laws. The third-party monitor shall adhere to ethical standards and guidelines in the collection, analysis, and reporting of public comments. In addition to other safeguards in the process, the third-party monitor shall ensure that comments are limited to one per interested individual. As used in this section, the term "third-party monitor" shall mean an independent entity or organization contracted to monitor and analyze public comments related to Department projects. The Department is authorized to promulgate rules necessary to effectuate the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
