The Department Service Oklahoma upon 17 canceling or denying the driver license of a person or upon 18 suspending or revoking the driving privilege of a person shall 19 require that the driver license of the person be surrendered to the 20 Department Service Oklahoma. When the statutory requirements for 21 reinstatement are met in accordance with Oklahoma Statutes, the 22 person shall apply for a new driver license from the Department 23 Service Oklahoma; provided the Department Service Oklahoma has

determined that the licensee is a person not prohibited from holding

a driver license under Section 6-103 of this title, and has successfully completed the customary written, physical and driving tests, if such tests are required. Identification of the person shall be verified through the driver license digital file of the Department Service Oklahoma.

- B. The Department Service Oklahoma, upon entering an order canceling or denying a driver license or suspending or revoking the driving privilege of a person, shall forward a copy of the order to the licensee pursuant to the provisions of Section 2-116 of this title and request the immediate return of the driver license to the Department of Public Safety, Oklahoma City, Service Oklahoma, or the order may be served upon the licensee by an authorized member of the Department Service Oklahoma. Failure to comply with the order of the Department Service Oklahoma shall constitute a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, the person shall be punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- C. Any peace officer of this state may seize the license of any person who, according to Department Service Oklahoma records, is under suspension, cancellation, revocation or denial under the provisions of this title. The officer shall immediately forward the license to the Department of Public Safety, Oklahoma City, Service Oklahoma.
