HOUSE BILL 3932

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to driver licenses; amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-209, which relates to the surrender and return of license; modifying description of responsible agency; authorizing the issuance of certain identification card at no cost; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-209, is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-209. A. ~~The Department~~ Service Oklahoma upon canceling or denying the driver license of a person or upon suspending or revoking the driving privilege of a person shall require that the driver license of the person be surrendered to ~~the Department~~ Service Oklahoma. When the statutory requirements for reinstatement are met in accordance with Oklahoma Statutes, the person shall apply for a new driver license from ~~the Department~~ Service Oklahoma; provided ~~the Department~~ Service Oklahoma has determined that the licensee is a person not prohibited from holding

1 a driver license under Section 6-103 of this title, and has  
2 successfully completed the customary written, physical and driving  
3 tests, if such tests are required. Identification of the person  
4 shall be verified through the driver license digital file of ~~the~~  
5 ~~Department~~ Service Oklahoma.

6 B. ~~The Department~~ Service Oklahoma, upon entering an order  
7 canceling or denying a driver license or suspending or revoking the  
8 driving privilege of a person, shall forward a copy of the order to  
9 the licensee pursuant to the provisions of Section 2-116 of this  
10 title and request the immediate return of the driver license to ~~the~~  
11 ~~Department of Public Safety, Oklahoma City,~~ Service Oklahoma, or the  
12 order may be served upon the licensee by an authorized member of ~~the~~  
13 ~~Department~~ Service Oklahoma. Failure to comply with the order of  
14 ~~the Department~~ Service Oklahoma shall constitute a misdemeanor and,  
15 upon conviction, the person shall be punished by a fine of not less  
16 than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars  
17 (\$100.00).

18 C. Any peace officer of this state may seize the license of any  
19 person who, according to ~~Department~~ Service Oklahoma records, is  
20 under suspension, cancellation, revocation or denial under the  
21 provisions of this title. The officer shall immediately forward the  
22 license to ~~the Department of Public Safety, Oklahoma City,~~ Service  
23 Oklahoma.

1 D. No person shall have a property interest in the physical  
2 driver license issued pursuant to the laws of this state. It shall  
3 be the duty of every person whose driving privilege has been  
4 suspended, canceled or revoked to immediately surrender his or her  
5 driver license upon the request of any peace officer or  
6 representative of ~~the Department~~ Service Oklahoma.

7 E. Any person surrendering a driver license pursuant to  
8 subsection A of this section, shall have the option to make  
9 application to receive a Noncompliant Identification Card issued and  
10 mailed to them at no charge.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
