HOUSE BILL 4073

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring school security alert systems; necessitating the State Board of Education adopt a list; detailing minimum requirements of alert systems; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-149.4 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each public school district shall have and implement a school security alert and response system.

B. The State Board of Education shall adopt a list of approved school security alert and response systems. At a minimum, an approved school security alert and response system shall:

1. Automatically alert designated school personnel when an emergency response is initiated on-site by smartphone application, phone call, text message, or other technology;

1 2. Provide emergency responders with floor plans, caller
2 location, and other information to assist emergency responders
3 during a 911 call; and

4 3. Integrate designated school personnel with emergency
5 responders to provide real-time situational updates during an
6 emergency.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
