8 AS INTRODUCED

9 A Concurrent Resolution relating to a pending
10 application to create an energy corridor proposed to
11 be located within the State of Oklahoma.

13 WHEREAS, certain energy companies have declared their intention
14 to create an eighteen-mile wide corridor spanning a large portion of
15 the State of Oklahoma; and

16 WHEREAS, such a corridor is anticipated to be utilized for the
17 placement of large electric transmission lines, wind turbines, and
18 solar energy generation farms; and

19 WHEREAS, location of such assets and associated activities would
20 have to be achieved through the use of condemnation to force
21 landowners to allow the facilities to be located on their property;
22 and

23 WHEREAS, it is contrary to the interest of the State of Oklahoma
24 and the interests of private landowners to be forced to surrender
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1 their real or personal property or both pursuant to condemnation
2 powers.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
4 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
5 CONCURRING THEREIN:

6 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma
7 State Senate are committed to take all legislative action available
8 to prevent the establishment of said eighteen-mile wide corridor or
9 any other such corridor regardless of its width which would condemn
10 and confiscate private property to locate high voltage electric
11 transmission lines, wind turbines, or solar energy farms.

12 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma
13 State Senate commit to taking such actions that may be required to
14 prevent impairment to the beneficial use of such private property
15 resulting from the facilities themselves, any associated easements
16 for construction, operation or maintenance of such assets or that
17 would otherwise interfere with the unrestricted exercise of private
18 property rights by affected property owners.
