State Senate are committed to take all legislative action available to prevent the establishment of said eighteen-mile wide corridor or any other such corridor regardless of its width which would condemn and confiscate private property to locate high voltage electric transmission lines, wind turbines, or solar energy farms.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma

State Senate commit to taking such actions that may be required to prevent impairment to the beneficial use of such private property resulting from the facilities themselves, any associated easements for construction, operation or maintenance of such assets or that would otherwise interfere with the unrestricted exercise of private property rights by affected property owners.
